All About Faith Child Care

Faith Child Care is a Christian, non-profit organization that has been serving children and families of the Fox Valley since 1989. We are licensed by the state of Wisconsin to care for 85 children.

Our Philosophy

We believe that each child is a precious gift from God with unique and special qualities. Our major emphasis at Faith Child Care is to help children discover their God-given qualities while providing a safe, nurturing environment.

As a Christian center, we help children to learn compassion and respect for others and an awareness of the world around them. We teach and practice Christian values through modeling, prayers, singing and Bible stories.

Building strong relationships with parents is very important to us and we take a partnership approach to child care.

We believe that children learn best in a play-oriented environment in which each child develops school readiness skills at his or her own level. Through play, children learn to socialize and communicate their thoughts and feelings to others. They also learn to organize, problem solve and use their imaginations.

Our Program Provides:

- Nutritious meals (breakfast, lunch and an afternoon snack) approved by the USDA
- Parent's Choice® Formula, iron fortified infant cereal and baby food for children under the age of one year
- A safe, loving and secure environment with staff-child ratios that meet or exceed licensing standards
- The opportunity for children to learn Christian values through daily activities
- A theme-based curriculum that aligns with the Wisconsin Model Early Learning Standards to provide learning experiences which enhance every aspect of a child's growth and development
- Large outdoor play areas with a separate area for children under 2 years of age and gardens for our preschool and school-aged children
- Opportunities for family involvement through our Parent Activities Committee and Center-sponsored activities

Our Staff and Leadership

Teachers are trained in early childhood or elementary education, SIDS prevention and Shaken Baby Syndrome. In addition, the Center provides monthly opportunities for continuing education in early childhood and ongoing training in CPR and First Aid. Low turnover and longevity of our staff provides a stable environment for the children. The Administrative and Program Directors work closely with the staff and the Board of Directors to carry out the Mission of the Center.

Typical Daily Schedule for Toddlers and Preschoolers:

- Arrival and breakfast
- Learning center activities incorporating dramatic play, sensory activities, blocks, creative art, fine motor skills, music and books based on the WMELS standards
- Outdoor play
- Group and Jesus Time
- Lunch
- Rest time followed by quiet activities
- Snack
- Outdoor or supervised free choice of activities until departure

Infant schedules are based on each child's individual schedule as set by the parents
